In Rememberance

In this issue we feature Tuan Akbar Rumblan alias "Akbar the Great" formerly of 20/8 Mews Street, Colombo 02 who was a popular Street Magician.

Akbar the Great By Chandrasena Gamage

He was born on 6th December 1942. He was a chubby guy who had a pleasant disposition and always caught the eye of a pedestrian who would linger on to see his captivating street performance. "Akbar the Great" should not be mistaken for Prof Akbar ~ Wickramapala Alwis of the Govt. Film Unit.

Rumblan joined the Sri Lanka Magic Circle on 14th March 1974 proposed by Gate Mudaliyar A.C.G.S.Amarasekera (President) & seconded by Al Haj M.M.Cassim (Hony Treasurer)

His son Mohamed Zahir Akbar coincidently was also born on 6th December (1972) Very Magical indeed!!

Within a very short time Akbar the Great lived up to his famed name & his name soon became a household name in the field of magic. Akbar the Great was truly a great Magician in his hey day. Worthy of his pseudo name "Akbar the Great", in his own amiable style of presentation, showmanship & stagecraft, has been unmatched to date!

Being the first to perform & introduce the Zig- Zag Lady illusion & the Glass Box Illusion in the local arena, he certainly would have had a lot more up his sleeve to offer the local magical scene, if not for his untimely death in the Middle East.

> "As one would find Pearls in the belly of the sea shell.... As a lotus would grow out of the mud...... One may find a precious stone out of the rocks"...... was truly the Great Akbar!!

The above reminds me of how Akbar rose to fame. Performing daily, making the Colombo side walks his platform for magical display was how he gained his skill. Later on he joined the SLMC almost against the many odds!!.

He soon hit the limelight when he applied for the Sri Lanka Magicians National Contest in the year 1972 & won it hands down! He made history by winning it three times in a row, 1972 1973 & 1974 (Of course this record was broken later) As I remember he would enter the stage only a few minutes before the show, his wife & brother in law would arrange the tables for him. A spool tape recorder was used to create music & sound effects synchronizing with his act. What a great effort and skill he used to put into his act to keep the audience entertained & spellbound! His pretty wife was his best trained assistant. Unfortunately his son has failed to take over as a second generation magician. There is an anecdote which tells a tale of how a pickpocket picked his Gold Medal presented by some fans at a carnival he performed with a newspaper reporting how a Magician got "picked"!!

With his ability as an Entertainer of Magic, Ventriloquist, Artist and Juggler Akbar got the opportunity to perform in the Middle East. Unfortunately thereafter, we never had the chance to witness his performance as he went to rest in the Hands of Allah in the Middle East itself.
